ACTIVITIES

Here are some short explanations of what some of the activities will involve, where they will take place and any special clothing that you will need to wear.

Bowling: At Worthing's Bowling Alley for the over 8's only. Socks must be worn, as you will be loaned bowling shoes to wear. Supervised by our Playleaders. Beginners welcome. Max number of children 12

Cooking: What will we cook? What do you like? Come and try and taste the results. All ages welcome. Whilst we endeavour to make this a healthy pursuit the children do have the ultimate decision and cakes prove popular! Please inform us of any allergies on your booking form as this will be on an as and when basis.

Film: This hilarious look at what really happens in a barnyard when the farmer's back is turned. "Barnyard" is a light-hearted tale centring around Otis, a carefree party cow, who enjoys singing, dancing and playing tricks on humans. Unlike his father Ben (Sam Elliott), the respected patriarch of the farm, and Miles, the wise old mule (Danny Glover), Otis is unconcerned about keeping the animals' humanlike talents a secret. But when suddenly put in the position of responsibility, the "udderly" irresponsible cow finds the courage to be a leader.

Fun Junction: A trip for the 9 year olds and under, to Fun Junction in Worthing and play in the large indoor adventure playground with ball pool. Supervised by our own leaders. Socks are essential, as shoes must be removed. If you forget socks you will be charged, as we will have to buy them at Fun Junction. Max number of children 14

Quasar: A lazer shooting game for the over 8's only, in the same building as Fun Junction. Max number of children 14

Walks: Destination chosen by the children on the day. There is no age limit on these outings, but we do expect the children to abide by any requests from the staff such as staying within hearing distance or keeping as a group when near the car park. Please ensure suitable clothing and shoes suitable for walking are provided as well as hats and jumpers dependent on the weather. Look for notices listing suggested destinations and ensure that you and the children are aware that these outings are for approximately two and half-hours.
